# Safely **to** School

## How to Use Your School Crossing Patrol

### The role of your School Crossing Patrol is:

To stop traffic so that children and adults can cross safely.

### Children and adults can help the Patrol if they:

- **Always use the crossing point** as this is the safest place to cross.
- **Walk** their bikes and scooters across the road so that they do not fall or slide into the road.
- **Keep hold** of skipping ropes and balls when crossing the road.
- **Stand back** from the kerb **and wait** until the patrol tells them it is safe to cross.
- **Always walk** not run across the road.
- **Cross in front** of the patrol, not behind, as it is safer.
